

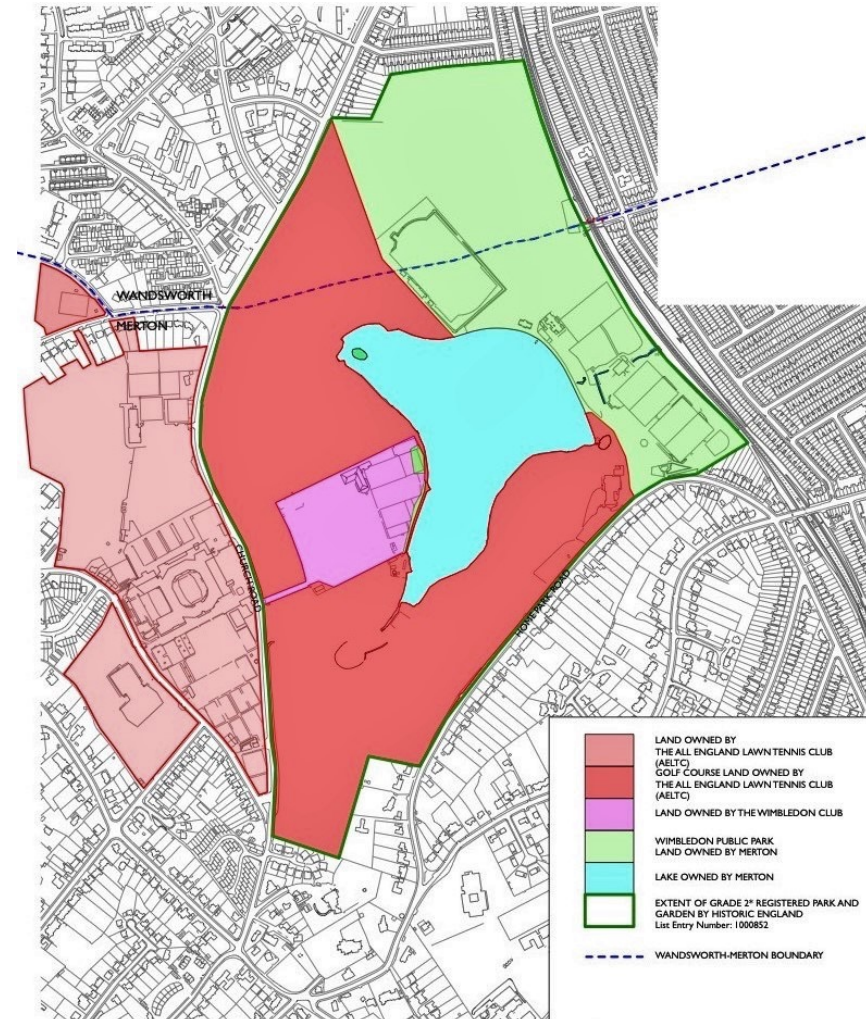

# Land Ownership Of Wimbledon Park



## Outline of All England Lawn Tennis Club (AELTC) plans

“we want to keep the championship *at the pinnacle of global tennis* and to bring the qualifiers from the courts at Roehampton”

- Covered stadium for 8,000 people with tunnel under Church Road
- 30,000 square feet industrial maintenance building for 150 men and 80 machines alongside Home Park Road
- 10 other buildings including players changing and rest areas, maintenance and transformer chambers
- 2 large hard standing areas for entrance
- 38 tennis courts with concrete surrounds

# Outline of All England Lawn Tennis Club (AELTC) plans - continued

- 9.4km of roads and paths
- 14 underground tanks, swales and ponds for water management
- Walkway across and partly around the lake
- Removal of a minimum of 300 trees
- Re-landscaping entire site
- De-silting lake
- Repaving Church Road to integrate both sides  
(= 8 years of work, thousands of lorry movements)

# Proposed Benefits

- Space for qualifiers and more practice courts
- Possible community use of golf clubhouse / stadium / limited number of courts after the championship
- Permissive access use of park alongside Home Park Road and of walkway part of the time

# Still required

- Car parking on golf course
- Queuing in Great Field
- Closure of Church Road for at least three weeks
