



NOTE OF ANNUAL GENERAL & PUBLIC MEETING

TUESDAY 20 MAY 2025, 7.45PM TO 9.15PM ST BARNABAS CHURCH

1. **Welcome, apologies for absence**

Charles Runcie welcomed all to the AGM. Apologies were received from Cllrs Kim Caddy & Guy Humphries (Wandsworth Councillors) & Kyle Forder.

Clive Williams was incorrectly listed under apologies for absence. The 2024 AGM minutes will be amended to correct this. The rest of the minutes were accepted without challenge.

3. **Chair's Annual review 2024/25 – click [here](#) to access**

Charles highlighted: an increase in overall membership to 580 on the database, healthy finances, increasing number of queries to the SGRA website, a well-attended general election hustings, 6 Executive Committees and 6 public meetings, improved social media, continuing co-ordination with other groups in the Grid, Councillors etc, and a successful Art Festival in March. Although much had been done in the use of social media, there was more to be done to make them more effective methods of communication. The Chair's review was accepted without challenge.

4. **Financial report 2024/25 – click [here](#) to access**

SGRA finances were in a strong positive position: £1,703 contribution to funds; advertising income exceeding Grid News printing costs; a year on year increase in street collections. He also showed a detailed breakdown of SGRA expenditure for 2024/25. Going forward, there will be agreed forecasts and budgets for SGRA's priorities and updates. Proposed changes to SGRA's constitution: changing the SGRA financial year to April to March; & removing the word 'audited' in para 8.1. will be presented to a Special General Meeting later in the year. The Financial report was accepted without further challenge.

5. **Election of SGRA Officers and Members of the Executive Committee for 2025/26**

All Officers: Charles Runcie (Chair); Ian Shaw (Secretary); Serena Potter (Membership Secretary); Ameet Phadnis (Treasurer) and members of the Executive Committee: Amelia Obertelli-Moriarty; Ann Kerr; Clive Williams; Kyle Forder; Rod Lewington & Sue Wixley were elected without challenge. Margaret Brett stood down from the Executive Committee but agreed to further assist SGRA in an 'Ex Officio' role. As the Executive Committee still had two vacancies, Charles asked the floor if anyone would like to nominate themselves. William Smart (Engadine Street) wished to be considered for a place. He was proposed by Ayesha Hasan (Lavenham Road) and seconded by Elaine Flanagan (Clonmore Street), and his nomination was supported by a majority of those present.

6. **Street representatives for 2025/26**

There were remaining vacancies in both Lavenham Road and Hanford Close. Ayesha Hasan put herself and Maureen Mills forward as Street Representative for Lavenham Road. This was agreed to.

7. Agreement of Annual SGRA Membership subscription

Charles proposed to keep the minimum amount to £5. When asked whether there could be flexibility in the minimum amount, Charles said that many subscriptions tended to be more than the minimum and therefore saw no need to change the system. The £5 minimum was accepted without challenge.

The formal AGM business came to an end.

Liam's presentation covered the make-up of the Arboricultural Team and their responsibilities (slides 1 & 2); their responsibilities for WBC owned trees e.g. inspections, replanting etc (slide 3); tree related issues concerning subsidence (slide 4); Tree Preservation Orders & Conservation Areas (slide 5); useful dos & don'ts when it comes to tree pit planting (slide 6); how to contact/make an enquiry to the Team (slide 7) – particularly useful for those who would like to have trees planted in their road/street..

Rev'd Vanessa Elston – Vicar at St Barnabas Church

After her arrival in January, Vanessa had noticed that local groups/organisation in Southfields e.g. SGRA, Green the Grid, Recycle More, and St Barnabas, by working together were creating a mutually supportive and flourishing environment. As Vicar, one of Vanessa's aims would be to build the Church up and to be a proactive contributor to improving sustainability in the Grid. As part of an Eco-Pilgrimage during Green Week (Sunday 8 – Friday 13 June), Vanessa will be walking through the Diocese of Southwark with a group of pilgrims and day walkers. In the evenings they would be stopping in churches along the way. On Tuesday 10 June, St Barnabas will act as host to an evening event and Southfields local groups and residents were invited to join them to celebrate and encourage local action on climate and nature.
